

**Southern Comforters Block of the Month**  
**August 2006**  
**Embellished House**

Cut fabric as indicated:

Sky:

- Piece A: Cut 2 squares  $6\frac{1}{2}''$  x  $6\frac{1}{2}''$

House:

- Piece B: Cut 4 pieces  $6\frac{1}{2}''$  x  $2''$
- Piece C: Cut 4 squares  $2''$  x  $2''$
- Piece E: Cut one pieces  $2''$  x  $3\frac{1}{2}''$

Door:

- Piece D: Cut one piece  $5''$  x  $3\frac{1}{2}''$

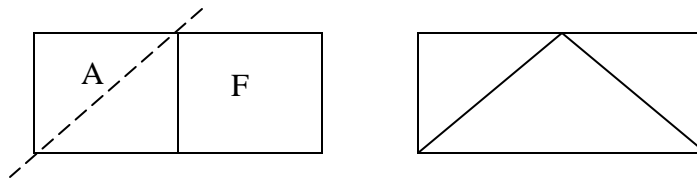
Windows:

- Piece E: Cut two pieces  $3\frac{1}{2}''$  x  $2''$

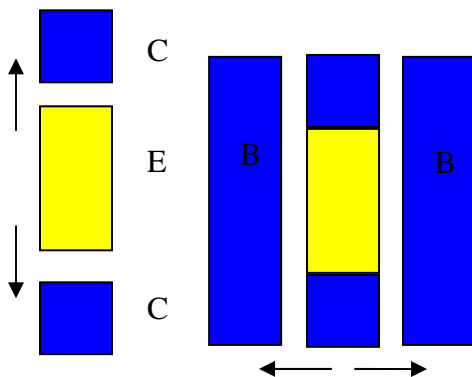
Roof:

- Piece F: Cut one piece  $12\frac{1}{2}''$  x  $6\frac{1}{2}''$

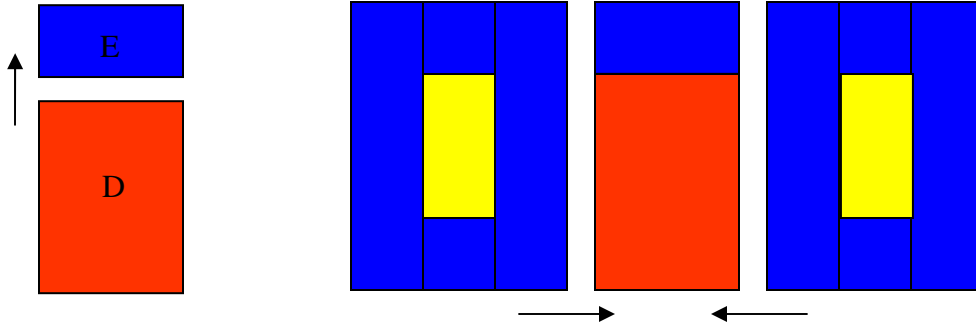
Step 1: Make a flying geese unit: Lay one piece A ( $6\frac{1}{2}''$  square) on the left side of Piece F. Draw a diagonal line as shown and sew on that line. Trim the upper left portion to a  $\frac{1}{4}''$  seam and press away from the roof. Repeat for the right side of the roof. This piece should measure  $6\frac{1}{2}''$  x  $12\frac{1}{2}''$  when completed.



Step 2: Sew the  $2''$  piece C squares to top and bottom of each of the two piece E window pieces. Sew a piece B  $2''$  x  $6\frac{1}{2}''$  piece to each side of this unit.



Step 3: Sew the piece E (3 1/2" x 2") on the top of the 3 1/2" x 5 " piece D. Sew the two units in Step 2 to either side of the Step 3 piece.



Step 4: Sew the Step 1 unit to the top of the final unit created in Step 3. Completed block measures 12 1/2" x 12 1/2".

Step 5: Add an embellishment. Suggestions include: embroidered chimney with smoke coming out of it, button for the door handle, curtains at the window or flowers along the bottom. ***You must add at least one embellishment to be eligible for the month's giveaway.***
