

**Southern Comforters Block of the Month**  
**March 2007**  
**Marching 4 Blocks**  
**CORRECTED VERSION**

This month's block is an easy block made 4 times and sewn together for a larger block.

Fabrics: Choose 2 contrasting fabrics. One should be a bold, crayon color (Fabric A) and the other a light solid colored background fabric (Fabric B).

Fabrics A:

- Cut one strip 2 ½" x 12"
- Cut one strip 4 ½" x 20"

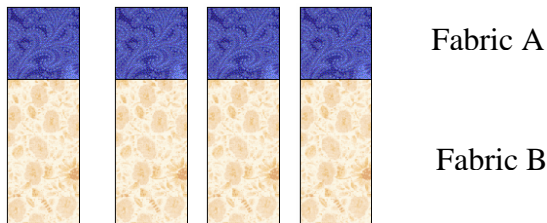
Fabric B:

- Cut one strip 4 ½" x 12"
- Cut one strip 2 ½" x 20"

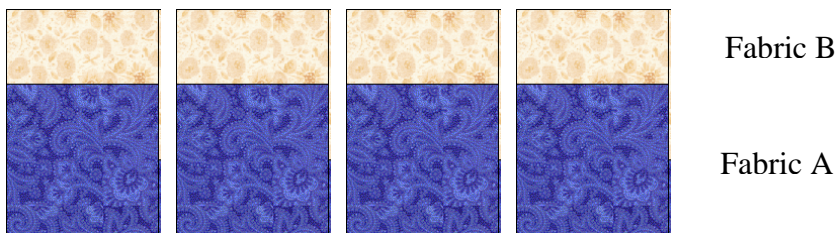
Step 1: Sew the Fabric A 2 ½" x 12" strip to the Fabric B 4 ½" x 12" strip. Press seams toward Fabric A.

Step 2: Sew the Fabric A 4 ½" x 20" strip to the Fabric B 2 ½" x 20" strip. Press seams toward Fabric A.

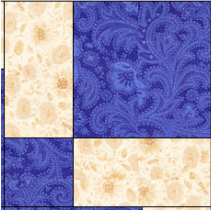
Step 3. Using the units sewn in Step 1, cross cut the strip into four segments 2 ½" wide.



Step 4. Using the units sewn in Step 2, cross cut the strip into four segments 4 ½" wide.



Step 5. Sew a step 3 unit to a step 4 unit as shown to make 4 units. They should measure  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ ":



Step 6: Sew the four units together as shown below into a  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Press seams.
