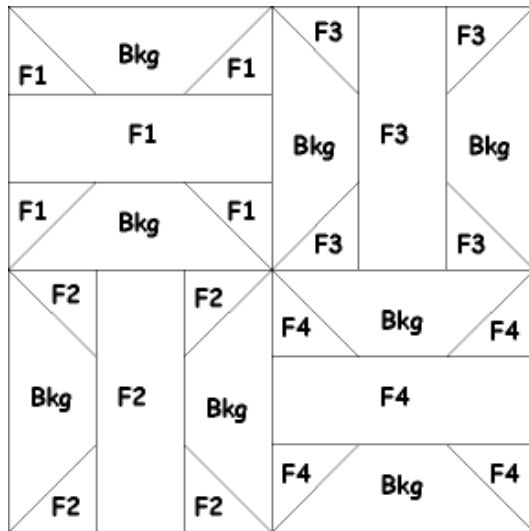

Arkansas Traveler Quilt Block



No HST's this month!

You will need 5 fabrics: an off-white background and 4 colors that will work together. Think Crayon colors. We will be making this one 12" finished.

Cut as follows:

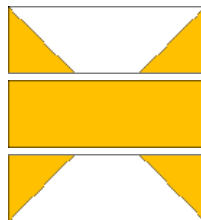
Fabric	Cutting Information
Background (Bkg)	Cut 8 2-1/2"x6-1/2" rectangles
All 4 Colors (F1, F2, F3, F4)	Cut one 2-1/2"x6-1/2" rectangle and four 2-1/2" squares

Sewing Instructions:

1. Mark the diagonal on the wrong side of ALL 2-1/2" squares.
2. Making sure that the squares are the same color on both ends matching right sides together, attach a square to both ends of a background rectangle; press open toward corners. Trim away excess fabric on corners.



3. Attach units from step#1 to opposite sides of the 2-1/2"x6-1/2" rectangle of the same color...press toward rectangle.



4. Join two units together with one oriented horizontally and one vertically; then join the new units...watching orientation carefully. Seams can be pressed whichever way works best for your fabric.
5. IMPORTANT: Please square up your finished block to 12-1/2".
