Patience Corner

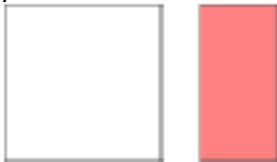
This block is for all of you who don't share my love of doing half-triangle squares. You will only need 2 fabrics to complete the block - a dark print and a light print. Think Crayon colors. We will be making this one 12" finished.

You need to cut as follows:

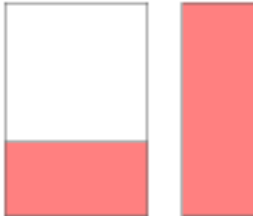
1. Light: cut four 4-1/2" squares..
2. Dark: cut four 4-1/2"x2-1/2" sections; and four 6-1/2"x2-1/2" sections.

Sewing Instructions:

1. Stitch a 4-1/2"x 2-1/2" dark section to each stripe square. I suggest you lay all your pieces out before sewing to make sure the stripes are running the same direction.

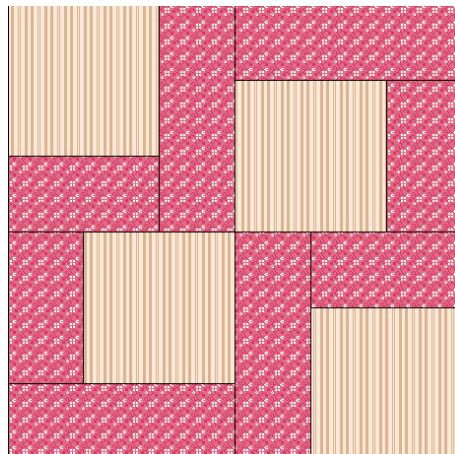


2. Stitch a 6-1/2"x 2-1/2" dark section to each light square unit



3. Join units together to create the block as shown below.

IMPORTANT: Please square up your finished block to be sure it is 12-1/2". If it is larger or smaller, check your seams and redo if necessary.



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
