

Dec 07 BOM Puss in the Corner

I was looking for a simple block to get us through the holiday season. We'll be making this one 12" finished.

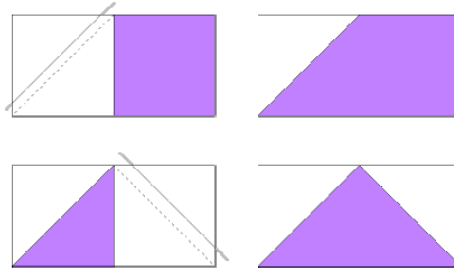
You will need 3 fabrics for this block: a large-scale holiday print, a jewel-tone fabric that reads as a solid and a white-on-white (WOW).

You need to cut as follows:

1. Large Print: cut one 6-1/2" square
2. Color: cut four 3-1/2" squares; cut four 3-1/2"x6-1/2" rectangles
3. WOW: cut eight 3-1/2" squares

Sewing Instructions:

Draw diagonal line on wrong side of all the 3-1/2" WOW squares; match right sides to right sides of one end of the color rectangles; stitch on diagonal mark; trim 1/4" toward corner and press toward WOW. Match right sides of the remaining WOW squares with the other end of unit...repeat stitch, trim and press.



Create 2 rows as shown; press seams toward end squares.



Create center row as show; press toward center squares.



Join rows as shown above, pressing seams toward outer rows. Please square up your finished block to be sure it is 12-1/2".
