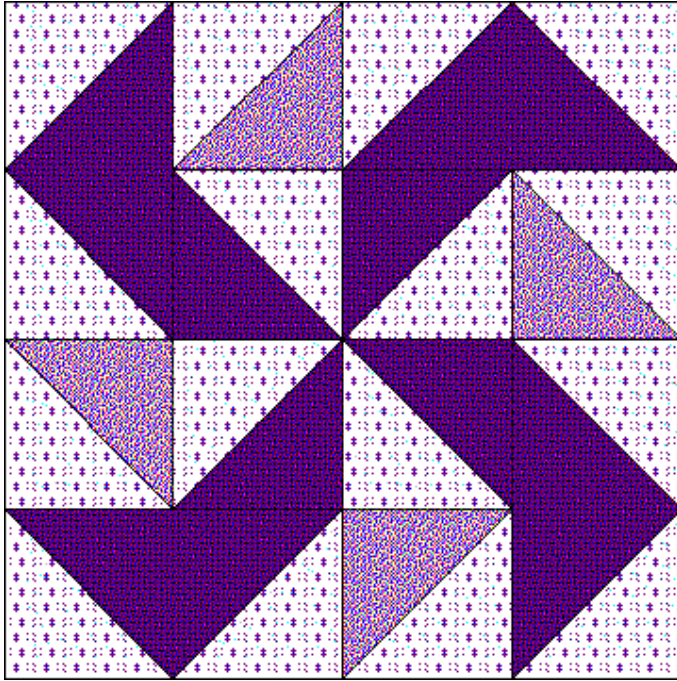


March 08 BOM
Yankee Puzzle



This is one of my favorite blocks, and in the spirit of St Patrick's Day we'll do it in green. There are 3 fabrics: dark green, medium green and a light background. You may use a white, WOW or a green print that is primarily white for the background. We will be making this one 12" finished.

You need to cut as follows:

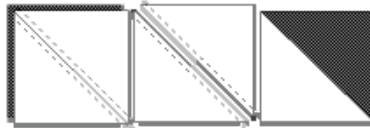
Light: cut eight 3-1/2" squares; cut four 4" squares

Medium: cut two 4" squares

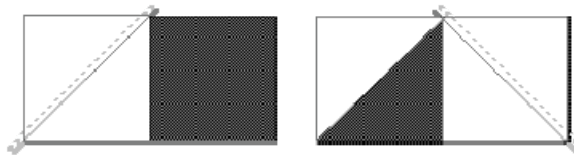
Dark: cut four 3-1/2"x6-1/2" rectangles; cut two 4" squares

Sewing Instructions:

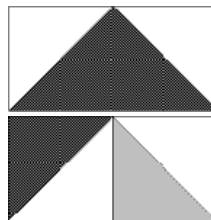
1. Draw diagonal line on wrong side of all light squares. Match right sides of light squares right sides of same size medium and dark squares; stitch 1/4" on either side of diagonal mark; cut apart on diagonal mark; press seams away from the light fabric. Square up HST to 3-1/2".



2. Matching wrong sides together, stitch a 3-1/2" light square to one end of the dark rectangles; trim 1/4" outside stitching; press seams toward light corner. Repeat with other end of rectangle.



3. Stitch a medium HST to a dark HST following graphic below for placement; press seam toward light fabric of dark HST. Join the HST unit to the flying geese unit from step #3; press seams toward dark fabric.



4. Using diagram as a guide, join all four units together to create the finished block.
