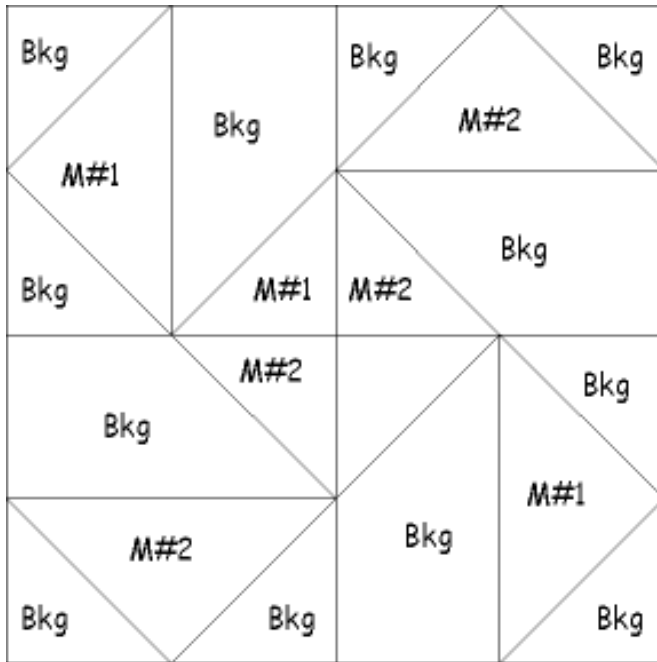


May 2008 Next Door Neighbor Block



You need 3 fabrics for this block: 2 different mediums of the same color and a light background. We will be making this one 12" finished. (NOTE: the area without a fabric notation s/b M#1)

Cutting Instructions:

Med 1 -- Cut two 3-1/2" squares and two 3-1/2"x6-1/2" rectangles

Med 2 -- Cut two 3-1/2" squares and two 3-1/2"x6-1/2" rectangles

Background -- Cut eight 3-1/2" squares and four 3-1/2"x6-1/2" rectangles

1	<p>Mark a diagonal on the wrong side of all the 3-1/2" squares. Using the 3-1/2" squares of Background and all four 3-1/2"x6-1/2" rectangles of Medium...place one square of Background on one corner, right sides together; stitch on the diagonal line; press open to corner. Repeat on other corner.</p>
2	<p>Using the same technique as in step#1...attach a 3-1/2" square of Medium to the right hand corner of the 3-1/2"x6-1/2" rectangles of Background.</p>
3	<p>Attach a unit from step #1 to a matching unit from step #2...press toward Background.</p> <p>Square up to 6-1/2".</p>
4	<p>Attach a Med #1 units to the Med #2 units, .press both in the same direction.</p>
5	<p>Join rows from step #4...press either way.</p>
