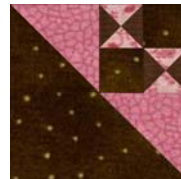
Just like a Whitman's sampler, our candy selection will have different centers. You have a little freedom on this one to make the corner (the cherry) your favorite 4 1/2" square. I've provided some suggestions below. We'll be using CHOCOLATE (milk or dark) BROWNS and coordinating PINKS for this block. Make your "candy" plain or frosted by alternating which side has the BROWN and which has the PINK (it will make for a more interesting pattern for the winners). The final block will measure 8 1/2".



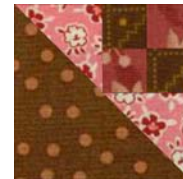

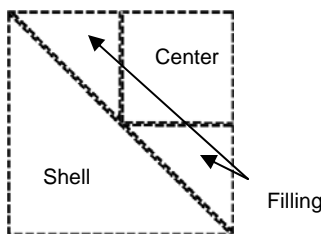

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS



SHELL:
one 8 7/8" square BROWN or PINK

FILLING:
one 4 7/8" square in alternate color from SHELL

CENTER (1 per block):
A: two 2 7/8" squares each of PINK and BROWN
B: one 3 3/8" square of PINK or BROWN
two 2 7/8" squares of alternate PINK or BROWN
C: one 5 1/4" square each of PINK and BROWN
D: two 2 1/2" squares of PINK or BROWN
two 3 1/4" squares of PINK and BROWN
E: one 2 1/2" x 5" strip of PINK and BROWN
F: one 4 7/8" square each of PINK and BROWN

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

- 1) Create your candy **CENTER**. Either make your own 4 1/2" square to include or create one of these samples:
 - A. *Pinwheel*: make four half-square triangles – place a PINK and BROWN 2 7/8" square right sides together, draw a diagonal line, sew 1/4" on either side of the line, and cut on the line and press the half squares open. Sew the four half-square triangle squares together.
 - B. *Square in a square*: cut the two 2 7/8" squares in half diagonally and sew each triangle to the 3 3/8" square.
 - C. *Hourglass*: make two half-square triangles (see A above) using the 5 1/4" squares. Place the triangles together right sides with the PINK facing the BROWN, draw a diagonal line perpendicular to the existing seam, sew 1/4" on either side of the line, and cut on the line. (makes two 4 1/4" hourglass squares)
 - D. *Wineglasses*: make two hourglass blocks (see C above) from the 3 1/4" squares, sew them alternately with the 2 1/2" blocks to make a 4 1/2" block.
 - E. *Four patch*: sew the two strips together along the 5" side, cross-cut the strip at 2 1/2", turn one piece and sew into a 4 1/2" square
 - F. *Half-square triangle*: make a half-square triangle (see A above) using the 4 7/8" squares.
- 2) Cut the **FILLING** 4 7/8" BROWN or PINK square in half diagonally. Sew the triangles to two sides of the **CENTER** block.
- 3) Cut the **SHELL** 8 7/8" BROWN or PINK square in half diagonally. Sew the new **FILLING/CENTER** triangle to the **SHELL** to make an 8 1/2" block. (Be gentle you are working with bias edges.) Sign it, please.
