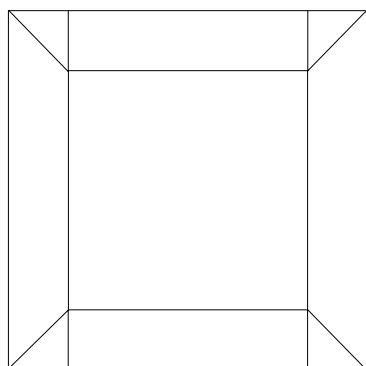
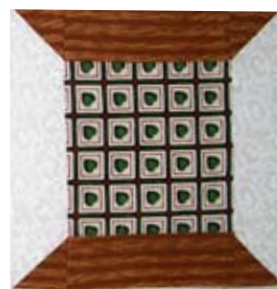


# Block-of-the-Month—July 2010

## Sewing Spools



Cut 1 square of sewing theme fabric 4.5"

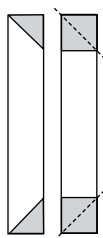
*This can be an actual sewing theme fabric or a stripe that simulates thread or a print that looks like a small quilt*

Cut 2 from white background—1.5 x 6.5"

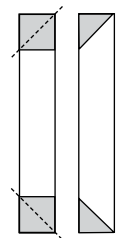
*This can be muslin or a white on white*

Cut 2 from wood/brown fabric—4.5 x 1.5"

Cut 4 from wood/brown fabric—1.5" square



Left side

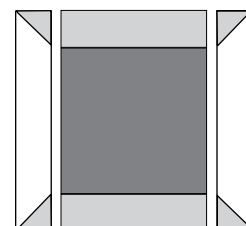


Right side

Place wood square at each end of white rectangle. Sew diagonal lines as shown. These are mirror images so don't sew each one in the same direction. Trim excess and press.



Sew wood rectangle on top and bottom of center square.



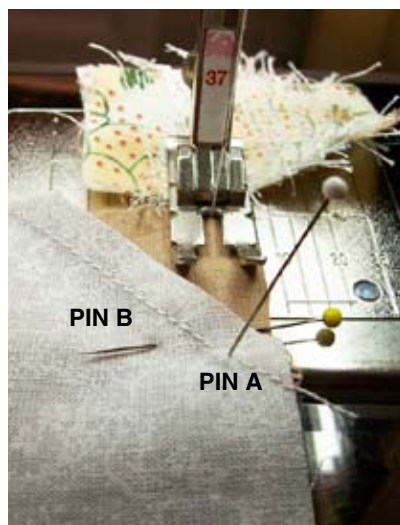
Sew side units to center unit  
Press carefully

### TIP-OF-THE-MONTH

Place a pin in the intersection where you want the seams to meet. (Pin A)

Place another pin *before* the first pin (Pin B) to keep the layers together.

Sew up to pin A, remove it and sew through the hole that it left.
